The threat of a massive dump at Ashdown Brickworks in Turkey Road has moved yet closer following the recent publication of East Sussex County Council's Strategy for Waste which seeks to confirm Ashdown as their preferred site for the landfilling of waste from throughout the County, including Brighton and Hove. If it is confirmed, ESCC wants to start a planning application as early as next year!

There is a **Public Consultation** from **October 21st to December 2nd** in which BALI and others will be making submissions to prove that the impact the dump will have on the local community is completely unacceptable and that the plan is unworkable as there are too many obstacles such as the lack of suitable roads to transport the waste.
