East Sussex County Council has identified Ashdown brickworks in Turkey Road as a potential waste landfill site. This will have serious adverse consequences for the environment and our quality of life; blight the landscape and unique flora and fauna of Highwoods.

Sandwiched between these woods and the Cemetery, with Bexhill High School within half a mile, and the Golf Club across the road, Ashdown is a totally unsuitable site for the County's waste!

Most affected will be the 4000 or so residents living within a mile of the site, but waste-lorry traffic will affect a far wider area, property prices will likely fall and it would set back seriously plans for regenerating Bexhill. Having hosted three landfills in the last 60 years, why should Bexhill be dumped on again?

BALI's aim is simply to stop the landfill. We started our campaign in 2002 with a small group of residents. Through widespread public support, we have become a force with which to be reckoned.

However, we still have a long, difficult, fight ahead of us. We have decided to reorganize BALI as a broad-based **membership association**, open to all Bexhill residents. For a nominal subscription you will receive a quarterly newsletter and the right to vote on important matters at the AGM.
